



Parks Community Centre Redevelopment

The Parks Community centre is a multi-agency project to redevelop and rationalise the existing Parks Community Centre into a mixed use precinct with a focus on sport and recreation.

This has been achieved through the rationalisation and renewal of existing buildings and the development of a high quality public realm capable of stimulating investment in newly created residential and mixed use commercial sites.

Tract worked with the various state and local government stakeholders to understand the range of objectives for the site and to consolidate these into a master plan and detailed design for the town centre.

Tracts approach was to maintain and enhance the impressive mature eucalypt trees and weave new landscape interventions through existing features creating a series of linked parklands that build upon the existing character of the site whilst providing new facilities and amenity for users.

The detailed design and construction of the town centre involved the development of a central plaza space, playground, residential and commercial streetscapes, reconstruction of the existing car park and a new soccer pitch.

Works are currently under construction with an anticipated completion in January 2014.
