



### Werribee Park Mansion, Victoria

Tract was involved in this award winning development from the initial landscape heritage investigations through to the design and construction administration. Our initial landscape heritage report was conducted in late 1997 and early 1998, which led to the approval for construction in 1998 to 2000. The landscape design built upon the rich open gardens and lawn heritage of this grand Victorian Estate with the sensitive use of a reflecting pool, gravel forecourt, siting of the circulation, parking and landscape elements for the Hotel, Winery and Pavilion. The work was completed in 2000 and was awarded the National AIA Lachlan MacQuarie Award for heritage restoration.
